COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS

TAKEN DURING 2025

Council and AGM Resolutions – 2025

1. July 2025 – Council Meeting

1.1 Export Goats

The decision that only one Inspector would be required for export goats was found to be unconstitutional, as it does not comply with the official Regulations.

Regulation 16.6 – Export of Goats: 16.6.1 All live goats intended for export must be inspected and approved by two (2) Inspectors, one (1) of whom must be appointed by the Association. The Council reserves the right to determine, from time to time, minimum production and performance requirements for export.

Resolution: The Council resolves that the practice be reinstated to two (2) inspectors for all export goats, as required by the Regulation.

1.2 Control of Show Animals

In future, improved control is required when show animals are offloaded.

Additional requirement: 4-tooth and 6-tooth ewes must be scanned.

1.3 Inspectors for Auctions

Production Auctions: One (1) Inspector is permitted, provided that the Office formally nominates and approves the individual. (Different inspectors may be used for different groups.)

Club Auctions: Two (2) Inspectors allowed.

National Auctions: Three (3) Inspectors compulsory.

2. October 2025 – Council Meeting

2.1 World and National Shows

A panel of six (6) Judges will be appointed. A Judge may not officiate at a show in which his/her own stud is being exhibited. The Judge whose stud is involved will be removed from the group of six before the judges for the day are selected. Judges may judge for longer than two (2) consecutive years, provided the above stipulation is adhered to.

2.2 Council Meetings Within Club Boundaries

Council meetings will henceforth be held within designated Club boundaries. A President's Dinner will take place during these meetings.

3. AGM 2025 – Resolution on Multiple Sire Mating (Multi Sire / MS)

3.1 Recording of Progeny Under Multiple Sire Mating

Three possible methods for handling and registering MS-progeny were presented to the meeting. Recommendation to the AGM: If the dam is known: The progeny will be moved to Appendix A. If no parents are known with certainty: The progeny will be moved to Appendix BS.

3.2 Resolution The Annual General Meeting accepts the proposal in full and resolves that the provisions regarding Multiple Sire mating and progeny registration must be incorporated into the Constitution of the Association.

He managed his farming operation with integrity and discipline. His herds were a reflection of his commitment: strong, healthy, functional, and exceptionally well cared for. Fouché always believed that good breeding is more than producing beautiful animals — it is about genetics, honesty, perseverance, and respect for the land and its creatures. These principles earned him high regard in both the Bonsmara and Boer Goat circles, where his knowledge and experience were always

shared generously. To his friends and colleagues, he was a man of unwavering character: sincere, humble, and dependable. He was the one you could call for advice, for an honest opinion, or simply for a cup of coffee and a proper conversation. Fouché's humour, keen insight, and genuine care for people made him loved by all who knew him. To his family, he was a rock — a man who protected, supported, and loved his people unconditionally. His legacy lies not only in his animals and his land, but in the people he shaped, the values he lived by, and the footprints he left behind. We honour a farmer, a breeder, a friend, a leader — but above all, we honour a man who, in his quiet way, made a profound difference. "The value of a person is not measured by the land he owns, but by the footprints he leaves in the lives of others." May he rest in peace. Our thoughts and heartfelt condolences go out to his family during this time of mourning.

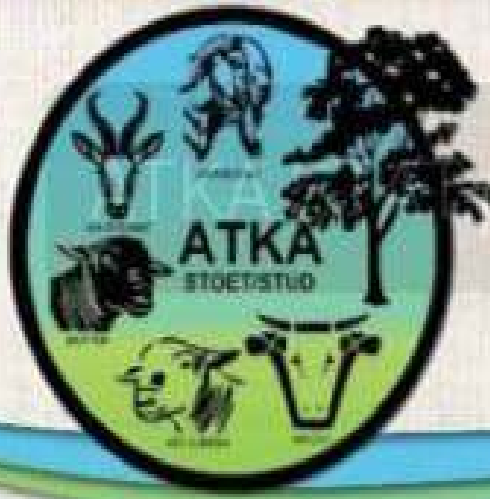

KAROO FIELD RAM GROUP – by Marlé Slabbert

In November 2024, the Karoo Field Ram Group gathered a group of 50 rams at a central point. These rams came from as far as Griekwastad, Putsonderwater, and Jansenville. The purpose of the project was to evaluate the rams in terms of adaptability, hardiness, growth rate, and recovery ability, and ultimately to present a ram after 10 months that had not only passed the test but had truly excelled. Only the top 32 rams progressed to the feeding phase, where they were finished with the auction in mind. It is important for buyers to understand that these rams were by no means pampered. They received no supplementary feed or lick in the veld — only basic health management to keep them free of parasites (internal and external). Everything else relied on the ram's natural ability.



Our aim was to present rams that were phenotypically correct, from top genetic lines, and fully adapted to veld and extensive conditions. I believe we achieved this objective with the top 27 rams that were ultimately offered at the auction.

The ram with the best overall performance started the test at 27 kg and, over the 10 months, maintained a total growth of 56 kg — an exceptional achievement. The group also included rams from well-known Alfa and Porsche bloodlines, which have already proven their ability to thrive under veld conditions. Furthermore, the project not only met its goals, but the fertility tests — conducted by veterinarian Ros Krige three days before the auction — confirmed that the rams sold had sperm counts of +4 and +5, values within the upper end of the spectrum.

As a group, we are extremely proud of the rams that completed the full project. The standard set this year was very high, and we intend to build on it with next year's intake. The rams for the 2025/2026 project have already passed the selection process and will be brought together on 17 November to begin the adaptation phase. The new group once again promises strong genetic merit with excellent phenotypic qualities. As we are admitting more rams this year, the competition will be even tougher. We are also very excited about Lionel's Vet joining this year's project, and we believe their contribution will significantly support the growth and progress of the rams during the veld and adaptation phases.
